School families are especially invited to attend the 10:30 Mass on Sunday during which our teachers will receive a special blessing.

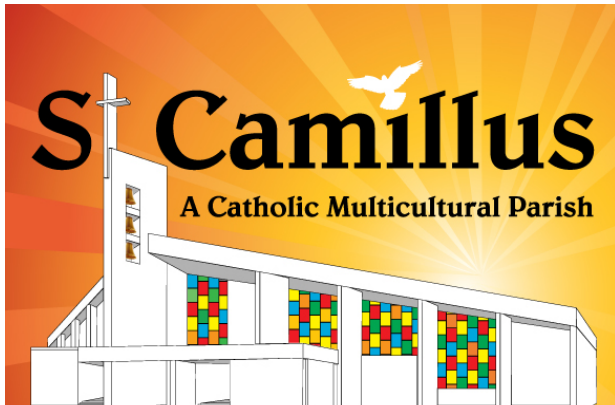


Tuition Payments

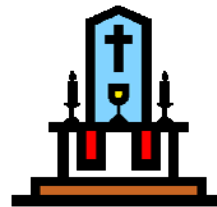
