Please be sure to fill out the testing authorization from Kaplan Tutoring.

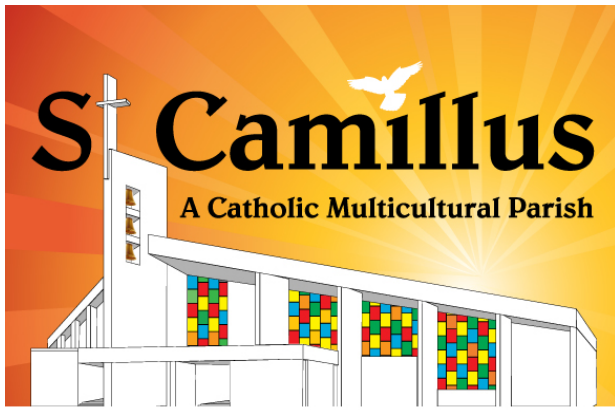
This will allow us to provide your son or daughter with a high quality math and language arts assessment that both we and you can use to help improve and target your child's education.
