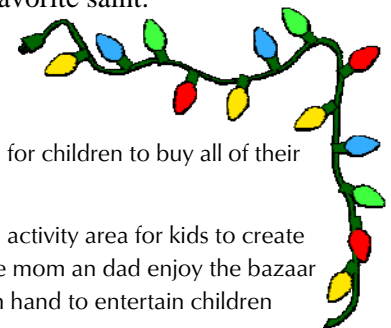
There will be

a Santa's Workshop activity area for kids to create crafts and play while mom and dad enjoy the bazaar and Santa will be on hand to entertain children

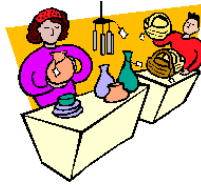
there will be crafts, baked goods, and white elephant items for sale and food and entertainment will round out a wonderful afternoon
