This year the PTSO is taking over leadership of the parish Christmas bazaar. They have designed a day full of activities for the whole family to start getting into the Christmas spirit.

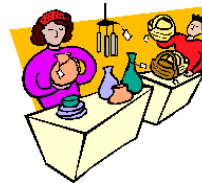


There will be
